Exciting news! "History came to life in Halifax County on Saturday as Virginia 250 debuted its Southern Mobile Museum during the Crossing of the Dan celebration. The traveling museum is one of two mobile exhibits operated by Virginia 250. One serves the Southwest Virginia region, while the Southern Virginia Mobile Museum covers the southwest region of the state. The organizers said the goal is to visit every middle school in the commonwealth, bringing history to students who may not have easy access to major historic sites and museums. There's different areas of the state where it's just so far away from maybe Mount Vernon so why not bring that experience to them and make it fun and easy to access," said Kat Smith, VA250's senior advisor for social media and communications. Smith said the mobile museum is designed to be interactive. "It's got holograms, it's got so you can kind of take quizzes, you can learn more about things, you can slide things or very interactive," she said.

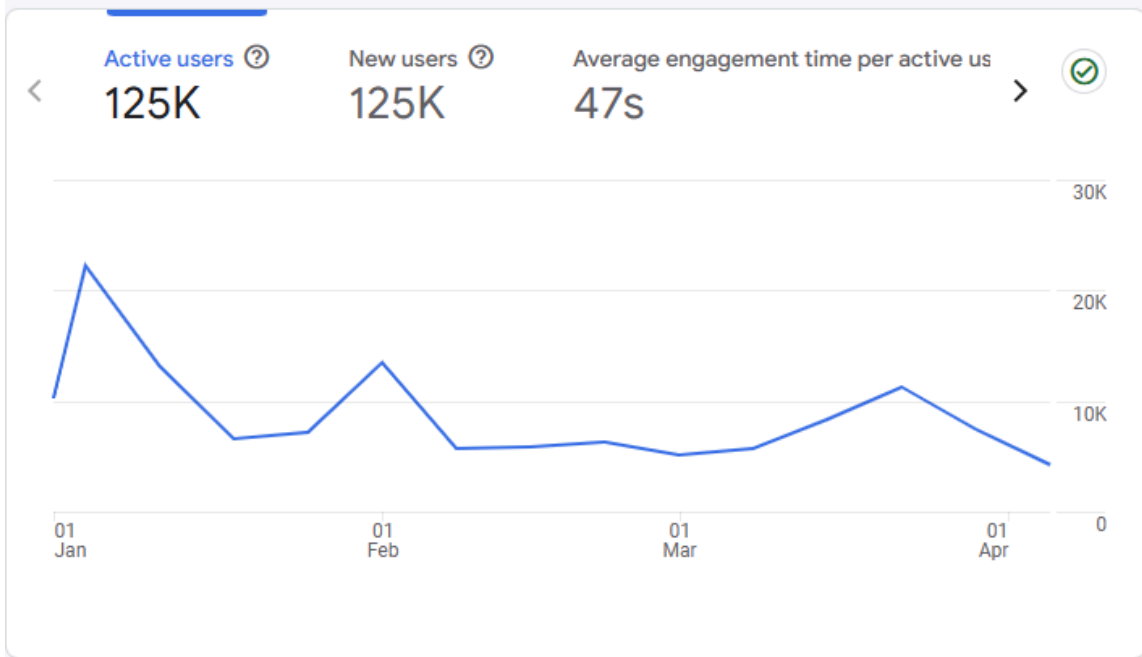
